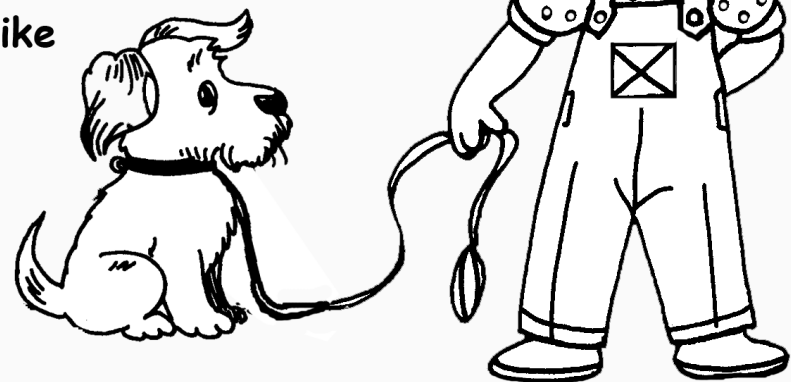
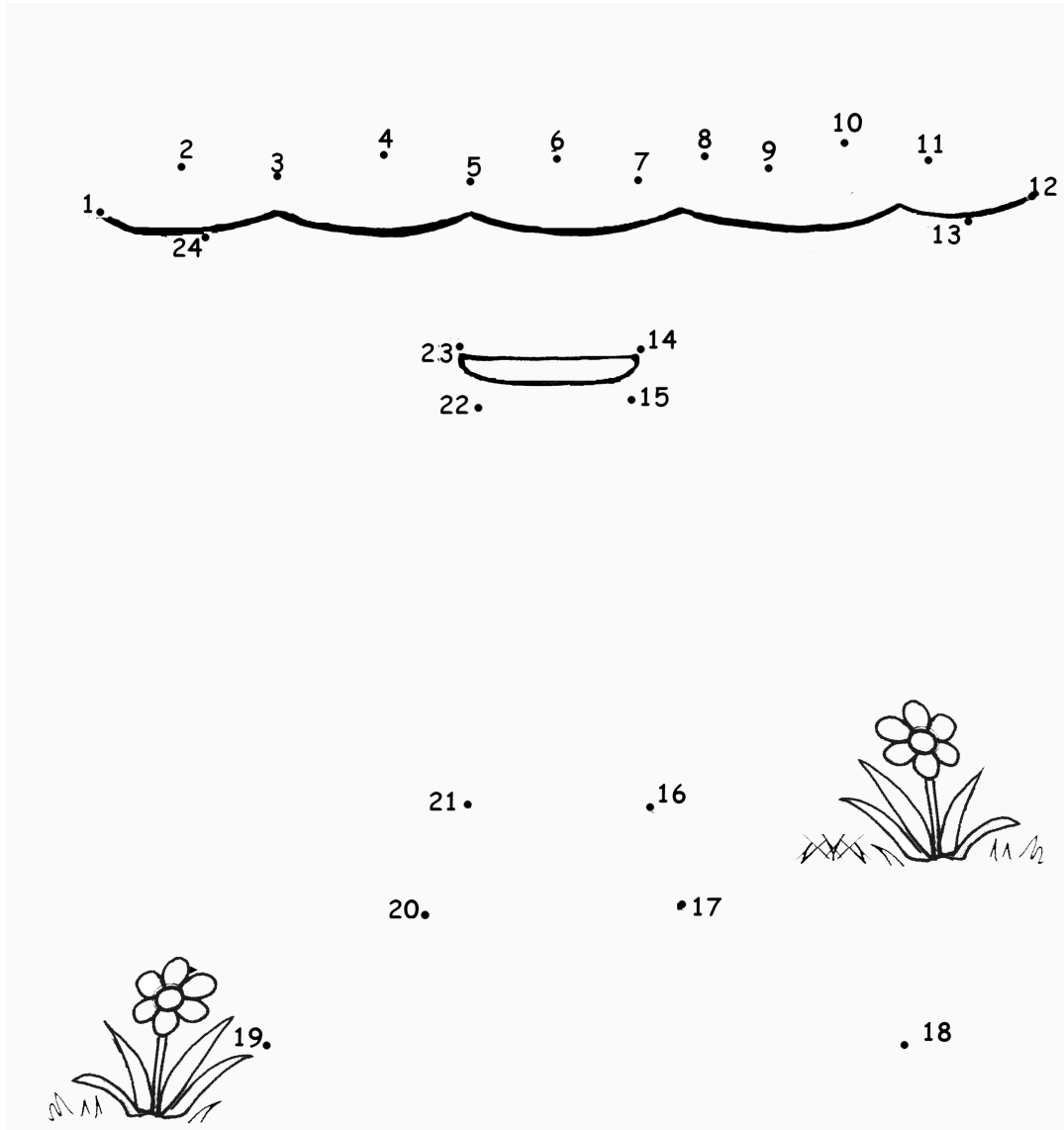


Kim and Duke would like to play in the yard. They cannot find the insect repellent. Will you help them find it?

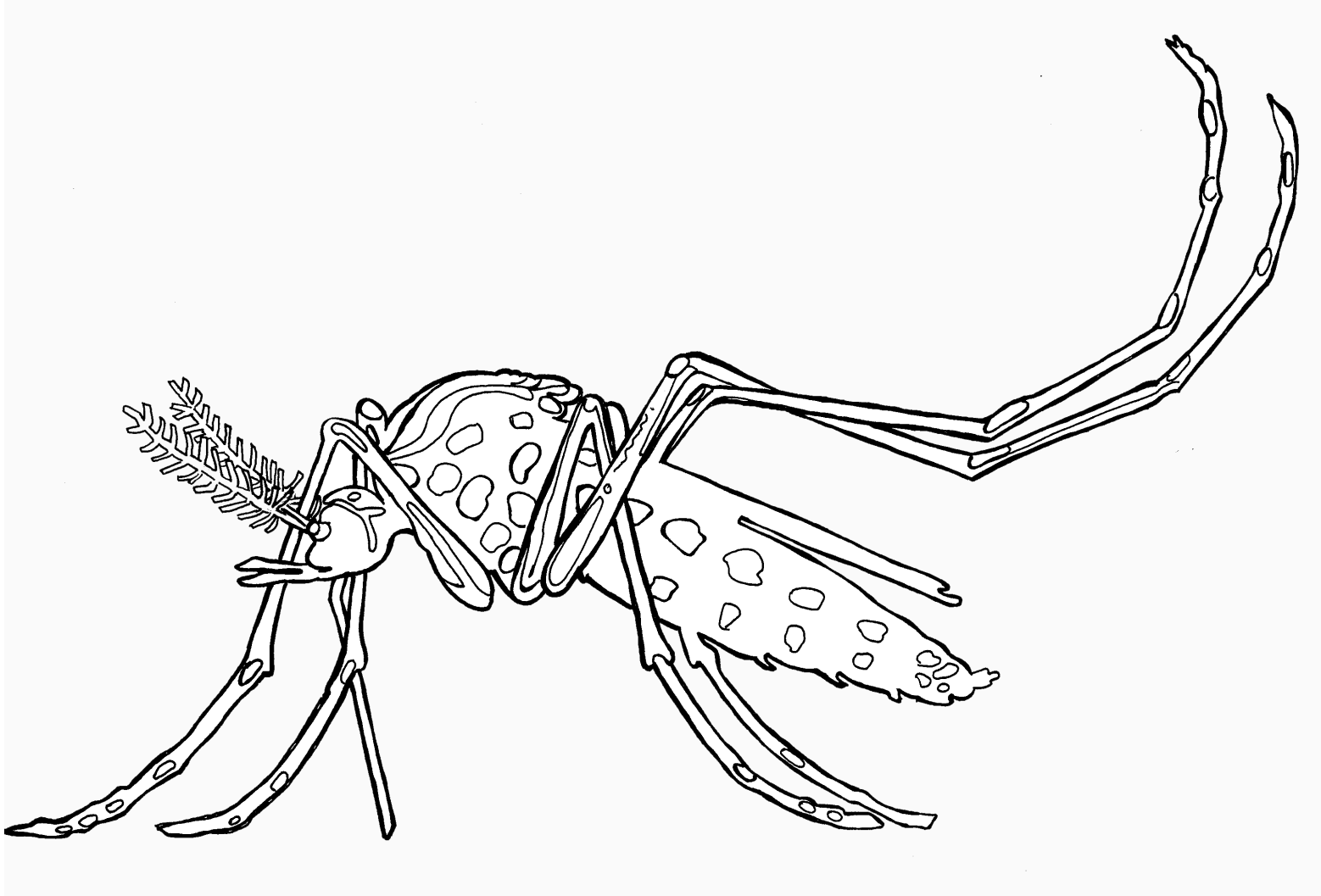
